



Environmental Incident Self-Report Form

Section 26 of the Private Managed Forest Land Council Regulation requires an owner to notify council within 24 hours of becoming aware that a landslide or debris flow has occurred and has deposited debris or sediment into an A, B, C, D, or E class stream. Owners are encouraged to self-report to council any incident on their property that may affect a key public value.
